Autism Diagnostic Process

“Testing options: There are many types of diagnostic assessments (also called testing), and it is important to pick the type of testing that fits your needs, budget, and timeline. The following options may be covered by your insurance and may help determine eligibility for services as noted. Psychiatrists assess for ADD/ADHD, anxiety, depression, bipolar mood, and they may be able to screen for Autism. If you are looking for medication for ADD/ADHD, only psychiatrists or other medical providers can prescribe (Psychologists and Counselors cannot prescribe). Physicians can sometimes assess for ADD/ADHD, and pediatricians can screen for Autism at certain ages.”

“Some colleges have free or reduced-cost testing services if you are struggling with learning, memory, or completing assignments. If K-12 school is impacted, the school district may be able to assess learning, speech/language, information processing that can be associated with ADD/ADHD, and behaviors similar to children diagnosed with Autism. Schools and colleges do not diagnose, but testing can help determine eligibility for supports.”

“If you or your child struggle significantly with day-to-day independent living skills, and you are concerned with Autism or intellectual disability, the Regional Center may be able to provide diagnostic testing services and determine eligibility for Regional Center services. If you are applying for Social Security, they may be able to provide some assessment.”

“Private assessments, such as with Psychologists or Neuropsychologists, are sometimes covered by insurance. Every provider has their own policies and costs, and you can check with your insurance to see if a particular provider is an in-network provider, and if not, what the cost would be for you.” - Dr. Laurie Ferguson, [Spark Psychological](#)
